However, further investigation is warranted to determine if billing for missed taxes on a case-by-case basis may be necessary in order to fulfill bond payment requirements for individual special districts. Further collaboration and investigation by the Missoula County Finance Department will be necessary to determine and set a cohesive policy moving forward.
