c. Taxpayer ID No. 416214008 requests to be removed from RSID 913.

After discussion regarding the nature of RSID 913, the taxpayer withdrew his request to have his property removed in favor of Missoula County further exploring options to transfer the parks that are maintained through RSID 913 to either the relevant Homeowners' Association or the City of Missoula.

3. DISCUSSION ITEMS

a. Discussion regarding preferred process to present or resolve requests to be removed from special districts when statute does not provide a process.

Commissioners directed that any requests to be removed from an RSID Maintenance District be denied when the service is a general one (ex. maintenance of a park) by Clerk & Treasurer with a taxpayer right to appeal that denial to the Commissioners. Commissioners further directed that requests to be removed from an RSID Maintenance District be reviewed by the Commissioners at monthly Clerk &

Treasurer departmental meeting when the service provided is specific to a property or area of properties (ex. lighting district where the property does not benefit from nearby lights). Commissioners further clarified that no removal avenue exists for an RSID Bond District outside of paying off the remaining bond balance for that property.
