- 1) Missoula County Planning, Development & Sustainability is proposing amendments to the Missoula County Subdivision Regulations. You are receiving this email as a department, agency, or interested party to regulatory changes. **Any comment you might have is welcomed and encouraged. Our recommended deadline for comment is Friday, March 13th.** The Missoula County Subdivision Regulations distinguish between the Urban Area and Rural Area. Urban Area subdivisions typically include streets and nonmotorized facilities that reflect an urbanized environment. Rural Area subdivisions are characterized by lower density with rural street and nonmotorized designs. The Missoula County

Subdivision Regulations include Appendix A, which distinguishes between urban and rural areas. Staff discovered mapping errors in Appendix A which are also reflected in the county's Property Information System. Proposed amendments include corrections to Appendix A. The Urban Area in Lolo is proposed to reflect updated locations within the Lolo Water and Sewer District (RSID 901) Staff proposes updates to the Urban and Rural Area definitions in Chapter 2. Chapter 3 proposed amendments clarify the distinction between Urban Areas and Rural Areas. Proposed amendments also clarify Lolo's Urban Area. See Missoula County Voice.

2) Missoula County Housing and Community Development Survey

Missoula County is currently conducting the 2026 Housing and Community Development Survey to gather public input on local priorities related to housing, public infrastructure, community facilities, and economic development. Feedback will help guide the County's application for federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME funding.

The survey opened on March 2 and will close at 11:59 p.m. on March 31. It takes approximately 10 minutes to complete. Responses are confidential and anonymous. Residents can find the survey at missoulacountyvoice.com
